Town of Lovettsville to Hold Public Input Session for the Town Square and Town Center Park Master Plan Development

September 10, 2008 from 7:30-8:30 PM at the Lovettsville Library, 12 N. Light Street

September 2, 2008: The Town of Lovettsville has begun work on the development of a Master Plan for the development of the Town Square and Town Center Park (located west of the Town Square) with the help of Kimley Horn, a planning and engineering firm out of Herndon, VA. The goal is to produce a concept plan for the development of the two parks to provide an attractive and useful center piece for the Town.

Development of the Plan includes a Public Input Session where anyone who is interested will have an opportunity to view several possible concepts and provide input into the plan. The Town is looking for input from residents on desired uses, amenities, and aesthetics of the Town Square and the Town Park properties.

The Public Information Session will take place on September 10, 2008 from 7:30 PM to 8:30 PM at the Lovettsville Library Story Room at 12 N. Light Street. The Session will include a short presentation of the draft conceptual drawings for the parks followed by discussion and input from the assembled public. The concept plans will then be revised based on input from the Public and direction from Town Council.

The Town is looking forward to obtaining valuable input on the development of these parks. It is critical to receive input in order to develop a park that is an attractive place that residents and visitors would like to visit. All interested citizens are encouraged to attend.
